




A COMMUNITY WITH "EXCEPTIONAL" TALENT QUALITY AND COST

Waterloo is one of the fastest growing tech talent markets in Canada. In fact, between 2011 and 2016, it was the fastest growing tech labour pool in Canada and second fastest growing tech labour pool in North America with a 65.5% increase in tech jobs.

In a recent report, **CBRE called Waterloo's combination of tech talent quality** and cost "exceptional." The table below demonstrates the cost and quality of the tech labour pools in cities across Canada. Quality is measured as the number and concentration of software engineers with three or more years of experience and who have graduated from one of the top 25 computer science programs in the US and Canada.

Waterloo also boasts exceptional **average employment retention rates of 3+ years.** In contrast, according to payscale.com, even tech giants like Apple (2 years), Google (1.1 years) and Amazon (1 year) struggle to retain their talent in Silicon Valley.

Waterloo has a total computer, engineering and science workforce of 21,200, which accounts for 8.6% of total employment. Our community is also a key part of the Toronto-Waterloo Corridor – the second largest tech cluster in North America – which boasts a talent pool of more than 200,000 tech workers.

Tech companies can also turn to the Global Talent Stream program, which simplifies the immigration process. A permanent resident visa and work permit can be approved in as little as two weeks.



HOW WATERLOO CAN FEED YOUR TALENT PIPELINE



Waterloo is home to one of the top technical schools in North America. The University of Waterloo is home to Canada's #1 Computer Science program, Canada's #2 Engineering program, and the world's largest collection of math and computer science talent. The University's strength in computer science and engineering make it an ideal source of talent for both hardware and software companies.

The University of Waterloo is also home to the world's largest co-operative education program. The majority of their tech-focused students graduate with two years of on-the-job experience. These students are a low-cost source of work-ready talent while they complete their degrees and an excellent pipeline for your future workforce. In fact, final year co-operative education students in software engineering programs are hired for just \$2,800 per month (after applicable tax credits).
